Update from the clerk 10th June 2025

Stalmine Play Ground Area

Playground inspections for May 2025 have shown no issues, apart from weeds present around the play area, which have been treated by Wyre.

Photo ID Badges

The ID badges have now been produced from Wyre, and have been collected.

Memorial Project

The memorial project has been given the green light from Wyre, but I may have to look into planning permission for the flag pole. I will ask the Lengths man to make a start on the ground work for the area, and over June purchase the benches.

Woodland Survey

The Woodland report has now been completed in May, and there are 8 trees that require Ivy to be severed from the tree by using a handsaw, 2 trees that require pruning and 2 trees that require felling due to decay, and one that is crowning over a single storey building. I have spoken to the Chair, and under Clerk's delegations I will ask if the Tree Surgeon whom has maintained a high standard of work and knows the woodland if he is able to carry out works recommended in the report.

External Audit

All documents have been emailed to the external auditor, and I am awaiting a response from PK Littlejohn. All public rights notices are displayed within the notice board, and on the Council's website.
