CLERK'S REPORT

Road closures

Temporary road closure on Back Lane, Stalmine with Staynall, on 19 – 21 October 2020 for new connection works by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities, can be found on the council's website.

Temporary road closure on Wardley's Lane from 0800 hours on 5 October until 1700 on 16 October or until completion of the works within this period.

Temporary road closure on Union Lane, Out Rawcliffe from 0900 on 26 October until 1700 on 13th December or until completion of the works within this period.

Tree work

The annual tree survey took place on 10 September – the report is expected shortly. The first phase of the work to remove diseased and dying trees and to thin out the undergrowth took place on 21 September. Further works are planned in October.

Plantsman

The plantsman has given the fingerposts throughout the village a fresh coat of black paint and removed the broken and damaged fingers. The condition of the wooden figures is such that they are beyond repair and new fingers will need to be made.

Flower bed near Cold Row

Work commitments have prevented the sponsor – Little Simpsons Tea Rooms – undertaking the planting work. The sponsor has indicated it is still prepared to sponsor the plants for the bed.
