The parish council is seeking to fill two vacancies on Stalmine-with-Staynall Parish Council by co-option. Anyone co-opted will hold office until the fourth day after the ordinary election of parish councillors in May 2027. This is a simple process, in which the clerk will guide you. Full training is available, and guidance within the roll will be given from councillors and the clerk to the successful applicants.

Councillors have asked that anyone wishing to apply for the vacancy provide a short letter of application to the clerk via email or post. This should outline why you want to become a councillor and what you would bring to the council. Alternatively, why not attend a monthly meeting and see for yourself how the council operates. Meetings are held every 2nd Tuesday of the month at 7pm at Stalmine Village Hall.
