

**A585 Windy Harbour to Skippool project - Fortnightly roadworks update**

Skippool junction	Monday 10 June – Sunday 23 June	In certain areas, lane closures will be required while we carry out testing on street lighting at Skippool junction. This work will be carried out during the day between 9am and 3pm.
Skippool Bridge junction	Monday 10 June – Sunday 23 June	In certain areas, lane closures will be required while we carry out testing on street lighting at Skippool Bridge junction. This work will be carried out during the day between 9am and 3pm.
Mains Lane/Old Mains Lane	Monday 10 June – Sunday 23 June	<p>Improvements to Shard junction will continue with two-way temporary traffic lights on Mains Lane and Shard Road.</p> <p>We will be carrying out drainage repairs on Mains Lane on 12, 13, 14, 17 and 18 June. This work will take place overnight and with two-way traffic lights to manage traffic.</p> <p>We will be closing Mains Lane overnight between Shard junction and Singleton junction on 19, 20 and 21 June. The work will take place between the hours of <b>8.30pm to 5.30am</b>. It's safer to carry out this work during a road closure when there is less traffic on the road. Access will be maintained for residents. Road users travelling in the direction of Shard junction or Singleton village are advised to join the A585 Windy Harbour to Skippool bypass at Skippool Bridge junction.</p>
Lodge Lane	Monday 10 June – Sunday 23 June	No changes to road layout.
Garstang Road East/Poulton junction	Monday 10 June – Sunday 23 June	In certain areas, lane closures will be required while we carry out lighting tests on the bypass. This work will be carried out during the day between 9am and 3pm.
Windy Harbour junction	Monday 10 June – Sunday 23 June	In certain areas, lane closures will be required on the bypass while we carry out lighting tests. This work will be carried out during the day between 9am and 3pm.
